## ABOUT THE GULLY TERRACE™

**T**he Gully Terrace™ is a trademark that some of us here have on more than one occasion been asked the origin of. As the spokesman for our stalwart band and true, I can tell you that it is in fact a very real and narrow lane traversing a hillside just above the town center of Holmfirth in England's West Yorkshire county.

**I**n the graphic design, below, its location can be seen at the top of the hillside to the far upper right. The 2-story row house in the distance at the very crest of the hill is typical of residences punctuating the length of the lane. Among the residents of Holmfirth and along **The Gully Terrace™**, reside authors, painters, sculptors, artisans, friends and lovers.

**T**he River Holme passes through Holmfirth town center (below this drawing), and then flows in a northerly direction to join the River Colne just south of the heart of the larger nearby town of Huddersfield.
